Students are strongly encouraged to register in advance. Cancellation decisions are based on minimum enrollments. Please register in advance and help Community Education make the best decisions! Your registration also ensures that you will be contacted should there be a change or cancellation of your class. PCC offers easy options to register for class:

- By Mail or Fax: Complete the form below and mail to Portland Community College, PO Box 19210, Portland, OR 97280-0210 or fax to 503-977-4988
- By Web: Secure online registration is available through [www.pcc.edu/mypcc](http://www.pcc.edu/mypcc)
- By Phone: Call 503-788-6266 and choose option "2" to reach PCC Enrollment services. The line may be busy during peak registration periods.

## Registration Confirmation

Confirmation of class registration is assumed once you register. Students registering 12 days before the term begins and who did NOT use MyPCC to register, will receive a mailed copy of their registration confirmation. If you have not received a registration confirmation by the first week of class, you may call the registration helpline at 503-977-8888 to request one. This helpline is staffed Monday through Friday from 9am to 5pm. Students who register through MyPCC receive registration confirmation on-line.

## Dropping a Class

Please note that if you register for a class and do not attend, you are obligated to call and cancel your registration according to the Community Education drop deadlines ([www.pcc.edu/communityed](http://www.pcc.edu/communityed)). If you do not drop your class, the College will bill you for the tuition. You may use MyPCC at [www.pcc.edu/mypcc](http://www.pcc.edu/mypcc) or the phone registration number (503-788-6266 and choose option "2") to drop a class.

## How to Pay | *You have 4 options!*

- Option 1** View and pay your bill online 24-7 via MyPCC ([my.pcc.edu](http://my.pcc.edu)). After you login, select the PCC-Pay link located under the College Business tab.
- Option 2** To pay by phone, call 503-977-4234.
- Option 3** Pay in person at any campus business office.
- Option 4** Mail registration form and payment to: Portland Community College, P.O. Box 19210 Portland, OR 97280-0210

### **Payment is due the second Friday of the term.**

After that date, payment is due when registration is processed.
